

REQUEST TO DECREASE HOURS ON ONE DAY AND MAKE THEM UP ON ANOTHER DAY IN THE SAME WORKWEEK.

Pursuant to the California Workplace Flexibility Act of 1999, if an employer approves a written request to make-up work time that is lost as a result of a personal obligation, and the hours that make-up work time are performed in the same workweek in which the time was lost, those hours may not be counted towards the total number of hours for purpose for the overtime requirements, except for hours in excess of 11 hours in one day or 40 hours in one workweek.
